Government Reform	Limits the terms of members of the legislature to a maximum of twelve years in the house of representatives or senate	HB 626
Decreasing Traffic	Provides a carpooling income tax credit for qualified commuters.	HB 682
Economy	Exempts feminine hygiene products from the general excise tax.	HB 1143
Homelessness	Establishes the offense of loitering on public property and adds trespassing on public property to the offense of criminal trespass in the first degree.	HB 1209
Decreasing Traffic	Establishes a three-year pilot project that authorizes a vehicle with a single occupant to use the zipper lane for a fee.	HB 1271
