**GENERAL  
EXCISE TAX  
HB 1675**

Exempts medical services provided by licensed physicians and advanced practice registered nurses acting in the capacity of primary care providers from the general excise tax.



**CAREGIVER TAX  
CREDIT  
HB 1769**

Establishes a refundable Family Caregiver Tax Credit for nonpaid family caregivers. Requires the Department of Taxation to report to the Legislature before the convening of each Regular Session.



**MENTAL HEALTH  
HB 1830**

Establishes provisional or associate — level licensure requirements for marriage and family therapists, mental health counselors, and psychologists and authorizes insurance reimbursements in certain circumstances.



**EDUCATION  
HB 1655**

Requires DOE to work with the BOE to create a public digital platform by the 2027 — 2028 school year that shows how schools are adopting high-quality instructional materials for K-12 English language arts.



**NURSING  
LICENSURE  
HB 2415**

Allows the Governor to enter the State into the multistate Nurse Licensure Compact, which will allow a nurse who is licensed by a home state to practice under a multistate licensure privilege in each party state.
