Descriptive Title	Bill Description	Bill #
Decreasing Crime	The goal is to combat smash and grab crimes. The bill expands what a misdemeanor of property damage is to include someone intentionally damaging business property of \$100 or more.	HB 1231
Income Tax Reduction	Eliminates the income tax for single and heads-of-household filers making less than \$20,000 a year or \$40,000 a year for joint filers.	HB 2587
Employing More Teachers	Enacts the Interstate Teacher Mobility Compact to reduce barriers to teacher license portability and employment.	HB 2661
GET Exemption	Exempts foods and medical services products from the general excise tax.	HB 623
Returning Non-local Homeless to the Mainland	Funds allocated for ongoing return-to-home program, aiding eligible homeless individuals in reuniting with family to thier home state.	HB 2325
